



Get ready for a big splash next weekend!



The installation of a new bike-share kiosk is underway with 10 bicycles soon being available at West Church Street and Railroad Avenue (across from the Caboose) dusk till dawn, 365 days a year. The station location was selected based on proximity to community infrastructure resources such as park trail, parking, and easy accessibility and will feature a Bluetooth lock module kiosk. Residents will sign-up with the administrator via Rider App and will be given a code to unlock a bicycle, which will be free of charge!

Public Works have started the parking area of the new Bike-Share Kiosk across from the Township's Caboose. The project is expected to be completed in June.


More information on how to register for the Gloucester Township Bike program is soon to follow.
