Proud to be Silver Certified!

Congratulations to Gloucester Township and the Gloucester Township Green Team for being honored at the Sustainable Jersey Awards Luncheon on Tuesday, November 14th in Atlantic City. Gloucester Township was one of 14 municipalities in the state of New Jersey that was recognized for a Silver Certification at the ceremony.

In order to achieve this certification, the Township submitted documentation to show that it had completed a variety of required sustainability actions. A total of 34 sustainable actions were completed in categories ranging from health and wellness to emergency management and resiliency, on top of priority actions such as: energy tracking and management, energy efficiency for municipal facilities, and prescription drug safety and disposals.

"The 208 Sustainable Jersey certified towns demonstrate leadership and are a testament to how much we can accomplish toward the long-term goal of a sustainable New Jersey," Sustainable Jersey Director, Randy Solomon, said.

Gloucester Township is proud to be a certified town which means that it is proactive in improving energy efficiency and health and wellness, reducing waste, sustaining local economies, protecting natural resources and advancing the arts.

PUBLIC WORKS Fall Leaf Collection

Public Works has begun their annual leaf collection. Look for signs on the road.

Don't Worry! If you miss your round, they will continue to collect until all leaves are picked up. To make this program a success, please adhere to the following:

- Try to keep all leaves *unbagged* at curbside. If you must use bags, please use paper bags ONLY.
- Have all leaves curbside. Do not rake leaves into the street if it will block traffic.
- Do not mix trash and broken branches with leaves. This clogs the machines and your leaves will not be picked up.
- Do not park any vehicles in front of leaves during your pick up week.

Public Works will keep to the schedule as much as possible. Please allow for inclement weather, vehicle breakdowns, etc. If ahead of schedule, they may go into heavier areas, but will return on your scheduled week. Thank you for your cooperation!
