Gabreil Daveis Tavern House, also known as the Hillman Hospital House, is a historic building in the Glendora section of Gloucester Township. This tavern was built in 1756 near the Big Timber Creek and housed boatmen who used the creek to ship goods to Philadelphia. It was designated a hospital by George Washington during the Revolutionary War.

The historical Gabreil Daveis Tavern will be open for tours this Sunday, December 10th from 1:00-4:00 pm. Please note that this will be the last tour date before the tavern closes for the winter!
