

'Tis the Season for Snow!

Help Public Works during snowstorms by parking cars in the driveway!

Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the streets and highways, and an emergency exists, no vehicle shall be parked on the streets, highways or portions thereof indicated.

The above parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the streets have been

plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic. Any unoccupied vehicle parking or standing in violation shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic and any police officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.


