The Township continues to be an attractive place to do business as economic development further expands in 2018. In addition to a transformation of Blackwood Clementon Road, Gloucester Township can expect two other major economic development projects this year. Residents can keep an eye out for a Holiday Inn Express which is coming to the corner of Black Horse Pike and Lower Landing Road. Holiday Inn Express is an "express" hotel offering limited services at a moderate price.

The Holiday Inn Express will be a four story building with 73 units, and the option to expand to sixteen more units, making 99 units total. This “express” hotel is expected to not only generate revenue, but also give people a beautiful place to stay when visiting Gloucester Township.

Plans for a brand new assisted living facility, All American Assisted Living, at Lakeside Business Park off of Williamstown Erial Road have also been approved. The assisted living facility will be a two story building with 58 units total and will have a variety of amenities, activities, and medical services for its residents.

MLK DAY OF SERVICE: COOPER RIVER PARK INVASIVE PLANTS REMOVAL

When: Monday, January 15th, 9:00 am - 12:00 pm

Where: Cooper River Park
Haddon Township, NJ

Invasive plants negatively affect our forests, parks and open space. They do not provide the food source and habitat the area's wildlife depend on and reduce plant diversity by crowing-out native species. Volunteers will be trained to identify common non-native plant species that have over-taken the lakefront riparian buffers. Volunteers will be provided hand tools and heavy work gloves to cut invasive plants. In the spring, we will plant root native oaks & willows to try and out-compete those nasty non-natives from battling back.
