SNOW REMOVAL



Sidewalks and walkways are required to be cleared and treated within 12 hours of the last snowfall for safety purposes. Whenever the pavement and surface of any public sidewalk or walkway in the township becomes covered in ice or more than two (2) inches of snow it is the responsibility of the land owner or occupant to remove any ice or snow within 12 hours of daylight after the snow has fallen.

If you are an elderly or disabled resident, you can contact Camden County's Senior Snow Removal Program. Please note that the Senior Snow Removal Program has specific guidelines that will go into effect after each snowstorm of 4 or more inches of accumulation. At risk elderly or disable residents may contact Camden County Division of Emergency Management at (856)783-4808.
