GT Baseball Opening Day



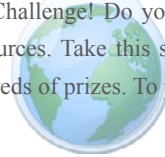
This past weekend, Mayor Mayer and Assemblywoman Gabriela Mosquera threw the first pitch at Gloucester Township Baseball's Opening Day.
