Thursday, July 5th, CBS This Morning highlighted two Gloucester Township community leaders who recently organized a neighborhood clean-up in Brittany Woods. Carolyn Grace and Shirley Johnson launched their community organization 2.5 years ago and this year they led a group of volunteers for their second annual clean-up day.

"It's a good community. It's a community that needs people to care about it," said Carolyn Grace.

With trash bags, rakes, and spray-paint, the group was out to change the image of their neighborhood where 35 out of 30 homes were abandoned just 3 years ago.

"This particular development was one of the shining stars in Gloucester Township back in the day. But through the 80's a lot of absentee landlords bought properties here so the neighborhood went through a decline," says Mayor Mayer.

Getting things done often takes cooperation with local government; and since 2.5 years ago, the roads have been paved, home improvements have taken off, and the new playground is now in place. "It's really about civic re-engagement.

I believe in local government because that's where we have to solve problems. I don't know what they are doing in Washington, but we are solving problems here... locally," said Mayor Mayer.

Improving police relationship has also been a priority for the past decade with efforts to reinforce commitment to the children of Brittany Woods. All the efforts have paid off and from 35 abandoned homes three years ago, the neighborhood is down to just two!

Bike Repair Stations Are Now Available

In the past several months, Gloucester Township has successfully introduced two bike programs: GT Bike Share, a free bike kiosk, and GTWheels Sustainable Bike Library which operates on donated bikes. Both programs are in close proximity to our health and fitness trail and now we are excited to announce that three new bike repair stations have been installed along the trail at the following locations:

- Beginning of bike trail Central Avenue in the Grenloch section of GT
- Bike Kiosk Church Street in the Blackwood section of GT
- End of bike trail Landing Road in the Hilltop section of GT

The repair stations give riders the option to hang their bikes up to work on as well as provide the link on the top of the station should anyone require help fixing the bike.

The repair kit includes the following:

- Phillips and Standard screwdrivers
- 2. Steel core tire levers (2)
- 3. Pedal wrench
- 4. 8/10 and 9/11 mm wrenches
- 5. T-25 Torx
- 6. Hex key set
- 7. Air Pump
