The Gloucester Township Police Department understands the importance of building and maintaining effective community partnerships. As a part of their Community Policing initiative, they introduced the Community Outreach Vehicle in Summer 2017.

The Community Outreach vehicle is a police special service vehicle with video gaming systems and other activities for children. The vehicle was manufactured in 2002 and re-purposed to serve as the mobile commu-

nity policing command center. The vehicle visits neighborhoods while staffed with police officers in order to bring the community and police together and give children the opportunity to interact with officers in a positive way.


