GLENDORA FIRE RECEIVES DRONE

Airborne Works founded and introduced a drone donation program whereby public safety departments nationwide may apply to receive an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV), new life-saving technology, at no cost. Airborne Works looks to partner with drone manufacturers and repair facilities as well as individual drone owners who are willing to donate equipment, services or financial support to the program. Donated equipment must meet basic minimum hardware requirements and are thoroughly tested and repaired by Airborne Works before being given to a public safety department. The availability of UAV / UAS technology, or drones, can often mean the difference between life and death, measured in seconds and minutes in emergency situations. Airborne Works hopes to alleviate this challenge and help to put “eyes in the sky for every department in need.”

On Friday, December 7th, the National Public Safety Drone Donation Program and New Jersey American Water presented a drone to the Glendora Fire Company. Glendora Fire Company was thrilled to accept this brand new life-saving technology as they are always looking for new ways to provide Gloucester Township residents and the surrounding communities with exceptional service.

On Thursday, December 6th, Mayor David Mayer cut the ribbon for Revel Nail, a large manufacturer located right here in Gloucester Township. Revel is a cosmetic company that produces high quality nail products, such as "dip powder." Dip powder is a powder that is applied to the nails to achieve a gorgeous manicure. Instead of using UV rays to seal in the polish, the color comes from a pigmented powder.

Revel Nail was started by *Phon and Keeli Malone and Reed and Monica Sutton* five years ago. With previous locations in Turnersville and Westville, they recently relocated to Gloucester Township to open one centralized distribution center. Revel has 80 employees and distributes their products to local salons, as well as to 45 different countries.

Winter classes will begin January 2. Registration for the Spring Session will begin February 25, 2019.
