"GLOUCESTER TWP. – The Dave & Buster's chain has set an April 2020 opening date for a restaurant and entertainment center here, a shopping center operator said Monday.

The 40,000-square-foot attraction will be "an essential addition to Gloucester Premium Outlets," said Simon Property Group, which operates the Gloucester Township complex.

It said the new business, with arcade games, a sports bar and other offerings, will operate on a free-standing site at College and Premium Outlet drives, parallel to Route 42.

The site will be the first in South Jersey for Dave & Buster's a Texas-based chain that plans to open about 15 stores in its current fiscal year.

The company has two outlets in Philadelphia and two North Jersey locations in Wayne and Woodbridge.

Dave & Buster's last month opened its 125th store in Fairfax, Virginia, bringing more than 200 jobs to the suburb of Washington, D.C., the company said.

Gloucester Premium Outlets has more than 90 tenants, including Calvin Klein, Gap Factory Store, Tommy Hilfiger and Under Armour.

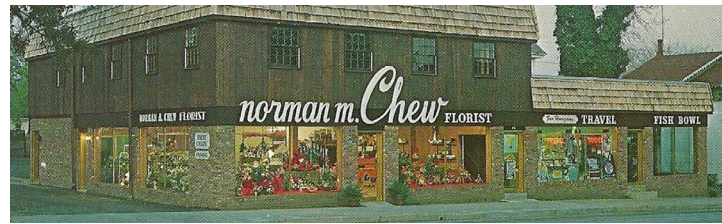
