- ★ **Never allow children to play with or ignite fireworks**
- ★ **Read and follow all warnings and instructions**
- ★ **Be sure people are out of range before lighting fireworks**
- ★ **Only light fireworks on a smooth, flat surface away from the house, dry leaves, and flammable materials**
- ★ **Never try to relight fireworks that have not fully functioned**
- ★ **In case of a malfunction or fire, keep a bucket of water or garden hose handy in case of fire or mishap**
