BUSY SUMMER FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Gloucester Township takes pride in its beautiful sports fields and parks around town. The Mayor and Council have always seen the importance of parks and recreation for the community, particularly the youth, to enjoy, engage in and stay active.

The Department of Public Works oversees the maintenance of township grounds, buildings, and facilities. In the pictures above, Bob Tyciak, Public Works Building Maintenance Supervisor, is inspecting his latest projects: scoreboards at the baseball fields, a brand new playground and irrigation system at Wye Oak Park, and a new facility at the Gloucester Township Police Department's gun range. Bob is in charge of all things structure, electric, plumbing, sprinkler systems and outdoor lighting of township properties.

The gun range, located on Hickstown Road, is where police officers go to practice and pass mandatory qualification every six months. It also houses an obstacle course designed for K9 training. The newly-constructed 80 x 50-foot pole barn at the gun range will house offices, classrooms, and a storage area for equipment.

Public Works also recently installed a new scoreboard at Kiwanis Baseball Field, home of Blackwood Kiwanis Little League. They also put up new railings and fencing around their club house as a safety measure to address parents' concerns. In addition to the new scoreboard that Glendora Little League's Field got earlier this year, Public Works recently updated the field's lavatories.



At Wye Oak park, Public Works built a brand new gated playground and installed a well and sprinkler system to beautify their sports fields and keep the grass lush and green for players.
