




The Safe Exchange Zone is a specific area of the municipal building for community members to conduct private party transactions and safe custody exchanges at the Gloucester Township Police Department. The GTPD is one of several law enforcement agencies offering an "exchange zone" as a safer alternative to other meeting locations, such as a private residence or retail center parking lot. The area is clearly marked with a yellow square and signage at the front of the Gloucester Township Municipal Building. Safe transactions can also occur inside the Gloucester Township Police station.

The GTPD encourages all residents to engage in such transactions during daylight hours, to bring a cell phone along in case of emergency, to notify friends or family of the intention to meet to conduct such a transaction, to never invite strangers to the home or agree to meet at a stranger's home, and to reconsider any transaction with someone who refuses to meet at a police department.
