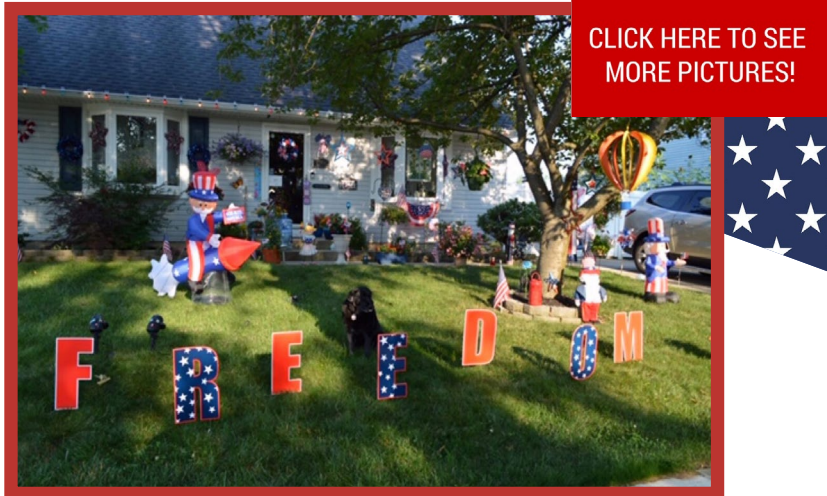

WEAR YOUR MASK!

Do your part and wear your mask in order to keep our Gloucester Township community safe!

A reminder to our residents that you are required to wear a face covering in outdoor public spaces when it is not practicable to socially distance and keep a six-foot distance from others.

Governor Murphy's Order also reiterates New Jersey's policy of requiring face coverings in indoor spaces that are accessible to members of the public, such as retail, recreational, and entertainment businesses, areas of government buildings open to the public, and mass transit buses, trains, and stations, again with exceptions for health reasons and children under two.

"As I've said before, we know this virus is a lot less lethal outdoors than indoors, but that does not mean it is not lethal," said Governor Murphy. "The hotspots we're seeing across the nation and certain worrisome transmission trends in New Jersey require us to do more. In the absence of a national strategy on face coverings, we're taking this step to ensure that we can continue on our road back as one New Jersey family."

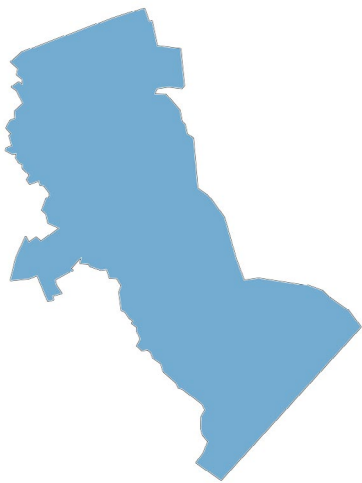

Camden County CARES Small Business Grant

Overview

Camden County has received federal funds from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act to assist struggling businesses during the COVID-19 pandemic.

"We know the business community, especially the foundation of our economy, small businesses, have been hurting and are in need of dire relief," said Freeholder Director Louis Cappelli, Jr. "We need to ensure that every proprietor and principal of a small business has access to these grant funds in order to help maintain and stabilize their operations. Moving forward the grants have the potential to provide a business owner with up to \$10,000 for COVID caused or related expenses."

Camden County CARES Small Business Grant Program

Grant Funds are being made available for Small Businesses that have been affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic. If eligible, your respective business could receive up to **\$10,000**.

Eligibility

- Applicants are prioritized based on COVID-19 related funds received (PPP, EIDL, etc.). Businesses that have not received COVID-19 funds are considered first
- Business must be located in Camden County since January 1, 2019 as a: Sole Proprietorship, Partnership, Corporation, Non Profit, LLC
- Revenue: Must be less than \$5 Million
- Size of business: Must have 25 or fewer employees (or FTEs)

Grant Funds are on a first come first serve basis.

Guidelines

In order to qualify for a Camden County CARES Small Business Grant, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Business revenue has been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic
- The business has been located in Camden County since January 1, 2019 or earlier
- The business employed 25 or fewer employees as of March 1, 2020
- The business earned \$5 million or less in total revenue during 2019
- The business must not operate in any of the following categories:

Banks or other financial institutions

E-Commerce

Businesses where the primary products or services are oriented to specific ages (vaping, liquor stores, etc.)

Franchises, except for those franchises which are completely locally-owned and operated

Requirements: Materials to Prepare for Grant Application:

Before proceeding with online application, please be sure you have all of the below information in order to submit your application:

- TIN/EIN – This is your Tax Identification or Employee Identification Number. If a Sole Proprietorship without employees, you will need your social security number
- Legal Business Name
- DBA – Doing Business As (if applicable)
- Business Contact Information (contact name, organizational role, e-mail address, phone number, and business address)
- NAIC S Code of the Business: North American Industry Classification System
- Tax Returns: Fiscal years 2018 and 2019 (if filed)
- Business Banking Information: routing and checking numbers
