This video by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission showcases one potentially disastrous risk: what happens when a tree catches fire-<a href="https://youtu.be/wNBTE71iQmU">https://youtu.be/wNBTE71iQmU</a>

The video compares two trees- one has been regularly watered and one has not.

When ignited, the dry tree erupts in fire almost immediately, while the watered tree bellows some smoke.
