COVID-19 VACCINE: Who is eligible for vaccination in New Jersey? Who is included in the vaccination phases?

The Camden County Board of Commissioners has opened a COVID-19 vaccination site at Camden County College. The site will be supported by volunteers from Cooper University Health Care, Jefferson Health – New Jersey, Cooper Medical School of Rowan University, and Rutgers College of Nursing and operate Monday-Saturday, 9am to at 4pm at Camden County College, 200 College Drive, Gloucester Township, New Jersey.

Registration is online only and includes: Group 1A, 65 and over, and people with medical conditions 14 to 64.

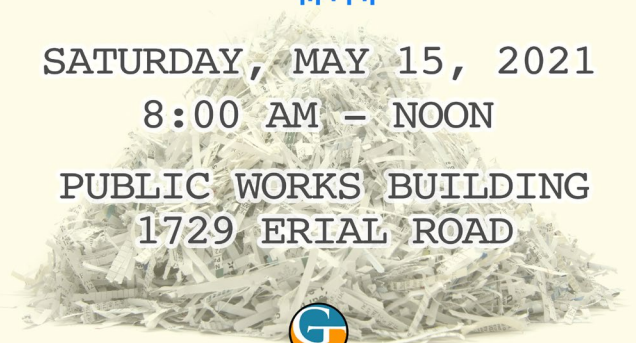

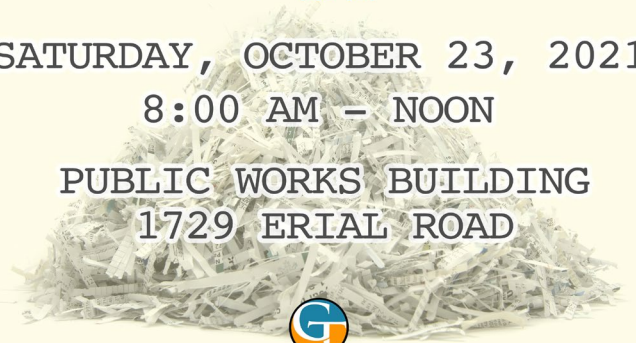
