# GTPD Renews Membership in the Missing Kids Readiness

Gloucester Township Police and Pine Hill Borough Police Department renewed their membership in premier missing kids readiness program designed to protect children. To renew their membership, and to meet the requirements of the Program, the Pine Hill Police Department and the Gloucester Township Police Department both worked with NCMEC on their missing child policies to ensure they met the critical elements of NCMEC's Law Enforcement Model Policy and Procedures for Reports of Missing and Abducted Children. In addition, the Command Staffs of both Departments have attended training, and all Officers, Patrol Officers, Detectives, Sergeants, Lieutenants, and Staff completed the online training required for their membership. The Gloucester Township Police Department Dispatch Center and Telecommunicators have also been re-certified by the NCMEC. Armed with the information, knowledge and operational resources gained through meeting the Program criteria, the Gloucester Township Police Department and Pine Hill Police Department both continue to position themselves to respond more quickly, comprehensively, and effectively when a




Are people coming to your door, selling solar panels or offering to replace the siding on your home?
