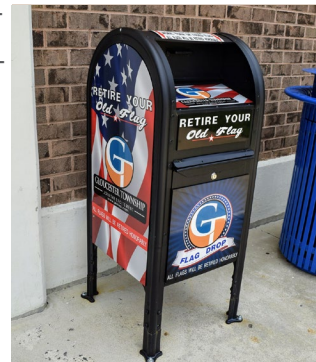


GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP REVEALS FLAG DROP-OFF BOXES

This month Gloucester Township Mayor David R Mayer and Chief of Police David Harkins, in partnership with local township Veterans' organizations, revealed flag disposal boxes at three locations in Gloucester Township:

- Community Park by Veterans' Memorial

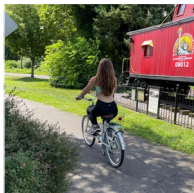

Camden County RECOVERS Rental Assistance Grant

CAMDEN COUNTY IS NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR THE CAMDEN COUNTY RECOVERS RENTAL ASSISTANCE GRANT.

The Board of Commissioners launched a new round of support for low income renters at risk of losing their homes or facing an eviction threat due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In total, the Board expects to award approximately \$15 million in assistance, using funds which were designated for the county as part of Congress' December COVID relief legislation.

The Camden County RECOVERS Rental Assistance Grant makes available up to 12 months of back rent (dating back to March 13, 2020). Utilities which are included in rent will be treated as rent, and internet services may be considered an eligible utility if it can be demonstrated that those services were necessary for work or schooling. While tenants will apply to take part in the program, payments will be made directly to landlords.

Applications for the program will be awarded on a first come, first served basis, and will be accepted until all available funds have been awarded. To apply, visit www.camdenrentgrant.com or call (856) 389-6704 for assistance.

Department of Health Offers Free Vaccinations in Camden

The New Jersey Department of Health will be offering free COVID-19 vaccinations in Camden over the next two weeks. No appointments are needed, and patients will not be required to show ID, documentation, or proof of insurance to get vaccinated.

The Department's Rapid Mobile Response Team will have all three COVID-19 vaccines available. Children ages 12 and above will receive the Pfizer vaccine.

"Even with cases down, this virus still poses an incredible risk to individuals who haven't been vaccinated," said County Commissioner Al Dyer. "If you haven't gotten your shot yet, this is the perfect opportunity to get protected. It's safe, it's free, and the entire process only takes 15 minutes."

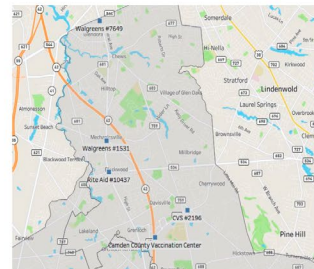
