Gloucester Township will bury a Time Capsule in Fall

June 2020 marked the 325th anniversary since Gloucester Township's incorporation in 1695. Gloucester Township plans to hold a time capsule burial in the fall of this year at the historic Gabreil Daveis Tavern.

Items of significance to the Township will be buried at the tavern to be dug up by future generations. The purpose of the time capsule is to allow Gloucester Township's heritage to live on for many years to come.

Local groups, organizations, and institutions are welcome to submit their items to the Mayor's Office by August 2nd, 2021, to be unearthed in the year 2070.

If interested, please submit the items of significance including, but not limited to photos, documents, small trophies, etc. All items must fit in a gallon-sized Ziploc bag.

In addition to your items, we ask that you also submit a group photo of your organization that includes your organization's name and the names of those pictured.



Sergeant William Rapp was hired by Gloucester Township Police Department in January 1998, and he is currently in his 24th year of service. He attended the Camden County College Police Academy Class 28, where he served as Class Leader. During his career, Sergeant Rapp has served as a Shift Investigator, Field Training Officer, K-9 Handler, Rifle Operator, and Firearms Instructor. In 2015 he was awarded the honor of GTPD Officer of the Year. Sergeant Rapp also served as a Detective in the Intelligence Services Unit, Retail Theft Unit, and Criminal Investigation Unit.

Sergeant Rapp was promoted to the rank of Sergeant in September 2019. He is currently the Deputy Platoon Commander for the Second Platoon. He was born and raised in Blackwood, NJ and he has lived in Gloucester Township, New Jersey most of his life.
