Gloucester Township Police Department Welcomes Class 1 Officers!



Paverart Mentions Gloucester Township's Neurodiversity Project



On Autism Awareness Day, April 2, 2021, Gloucester Township Police unveiled a new Paverart artwork/ paver project to recognize Autism and Neurodiversity. Paverart has recently released a wonderful video in which the GTPD's project is mentioned!

Paverart designed the artwork and Gloucester Township Mayor David Mayer authorized it to be installed directly in a prominent place in front of the Gloucester Township Municipal Building, so that more people would see it, which would then create conversation.


Paverart designed and delivered the pavers and materials for this project. The pavers were proudly installed by the Gloucester Township Public Works Department.

The Gloucester Township Police Department has created a registry for individuals with Autism or disabilities in efforts to give police quick access in an emergency to critical information about a person who is registered. The Autism/Development Disability Registry (ADDR) can provide police with emergency contact information, detailed physical descriptions, known routines, favorite attractions or special needs of an individual with Autism Spectrum Disorder or other disabilities such as: Alzheimer's, Dementia, Down Syndrome, or any other endangered individuals. This information can greatly assist police officers when time is essential in communicating and dealing with an emergency situation involving a person with Autism as well as other developmental disabilities.

The registration form asks for valuable information that police may need when helping individuals with Autism or any other disability. GTPD asks that all questions be filled out completely and a current photograph be provided. If you are unable to supply a photograph, GTPD can take one for you. The information you provide is confidential and will only be used by law enforcement. For more information on the ADDR go to:

Families are invited to submit the names and photos of their loved ones prior to the event to be shown as part of a remembrance slideshow. The slideshow, in the intimate setting of the vigil, provides a rare opportunity for families affected by loss to remember and celebrate their lost loved ones publicly. The photos also serve as a stark reminder that drug addiction has become ubiquitous, affecting diverse communities in our area and across the nation.


Please note, Camden County is not pulling lists from previous years, this is a new list and everyone will need to be resubmitted.
