
THE HERO CANINES VISIT GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP

CRC is a non-profit that provides strength, comfort, and emotional support to those experiencing intense traumatic emotions as a result of critical events.

The teams have responded to numerous crisis events over the course of 5 years: mass shootings at the 2018 Tree of Life Synagogue in Pittsburgh, PA; the 2017 Route 91 Harvest Music Festival on the Las Vegas strip in Nevada; the 2016 Pulse Nightclub shooting in Orlando, FL, and other tragedies.

The volunteers incur most, if not all of the deployment costs on their own. The organization relies on the generosity of community sponsors to defray volunteer costs for travel, meals, and lodging in responding to these events.
