### CHIEF DAVID HARKINS RECEIVES L.E.A.D. HOST AGENCY AWARD

Supported by dedicated police officers, L.E.A.D. provides the leadership and resources for law enforcement agencies to partner with educators, community leaders and families, and provide the only proven effective anti–drug, anti–violence curriculum for students K-12. Over the course of the 10-week program, officers and educators teach the curriculum to educate our youth on how they can make smart decisions without the involvement of drugs. L.E.A.D. currently operates in 37 states across the U.S.

Chief Harkins and his team at Gloucester Township Police Department became involved with L.E.A.D in 2015, and has recently attended his fifth conference at the Hard Rock Hotel in February 2020.

"The annual conferences are always beneficial as they allow us to keep up with certain trends and educational techniques," said Chief Harkins. "This year, the conference was particularly insightful as it provided us with strategies to better foster community relationships with law enforcement in an educational environment." Chief Harkins says that L.E.A.D.'s ability to educate children on the harm of drugs and violence is excellent. "Sometime students don't understand the life-altering impact that drugs can have on their lives, so it's great that L.E.A.D. drills them on the terminal effects of drug use at a young age," said Chief Harkins.

L.E.A.D. has been a huge part of Chief Harkins and his team's success in building positive relationships with the kids in their community. Knowing he is helping keep our children safe by creating a foundation of knowledge on the dangers of drugs and violence is most rewarding to him. 
