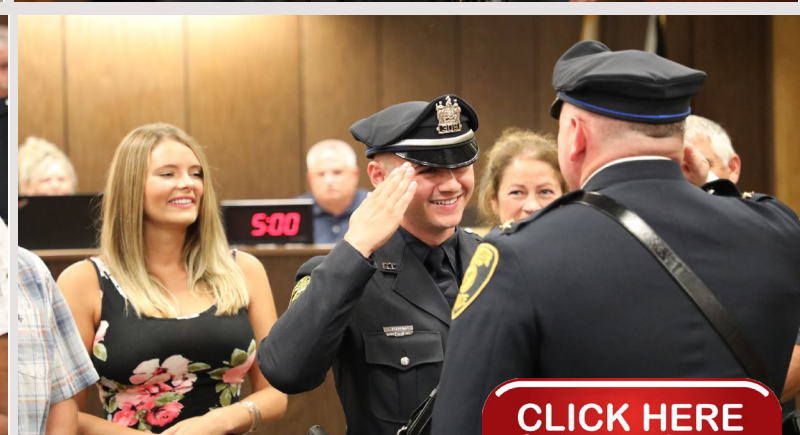
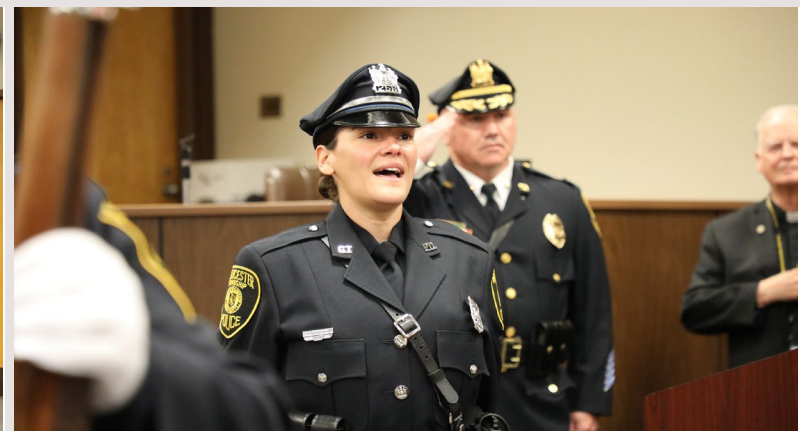

Mayor Mayer, Chief David Harkins, and Gloucester Township wished Earl Young a Happy 100th Birthday yesterday, August 11! Mr. Young is a long-term resident at Elmwood Hills Healthcare Center in Gloucester Township. Mr. Young was hired as a Police Officer at Pitman Police Department in the 1950's, and also served as a volunteer firefighter at Pitman Fire Company #1. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1943 for World War II, served in the Pacific Theater, and was wounded in Luzon Philippines from a mine explosion. Mr. Young was honorably awarded the Bronze Star and Purple Heart. He is a current member of the VFW and The American Legion.
