The Gloucester Township Historic and Scenic Preservation Committee celebrates Camden County's History Month. This year, we are showcasing old Post Office Boxes of the 1800s from the once Blackwood Post Office. The post office boxes were brought up from the basement of the Gabreil Daveis Tavern Museum House. Visitors will have the opportunity to learn about history and get a sense of what life was like back then through primary sources as they open, read, and sort copies of archived letters of the 1800s. The letters share history of local events, daily activities, along with sentiments and family updates.

Public Works: Advisory BRUSH, LEAVES, GRASS PICKUP

Branches, hedge trimmings, light brush clippings, et. must be securely tied into four-foot bundles that can be easily handled and the diameter of any branch may not exceed six inches. The bundles shall not exceed fifty pounds in weight. Public Works will pick up bundles on your designated day.

11/1 - 3/15 - GTPW collects bagged grass and bagged leaves WEEKLY on your recycling day with the exception of Friday which will be picked up on Thursday. GTPW will not accept plastic trash bags. Please note: grass clippings generated by a commercial landscaper will not be collected.

- Music to get participants energized for the walk

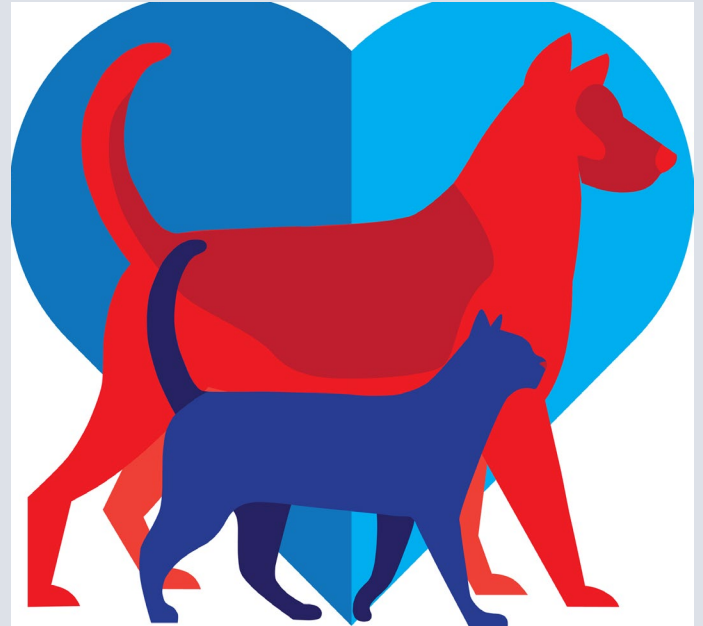
