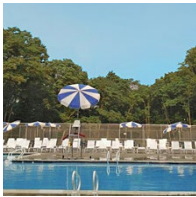

Gloucester Township is happy to announce that Gloucester Township summer camps will be returning for Summer 2022! Camps will be available for children ages 3 through 8th grade.

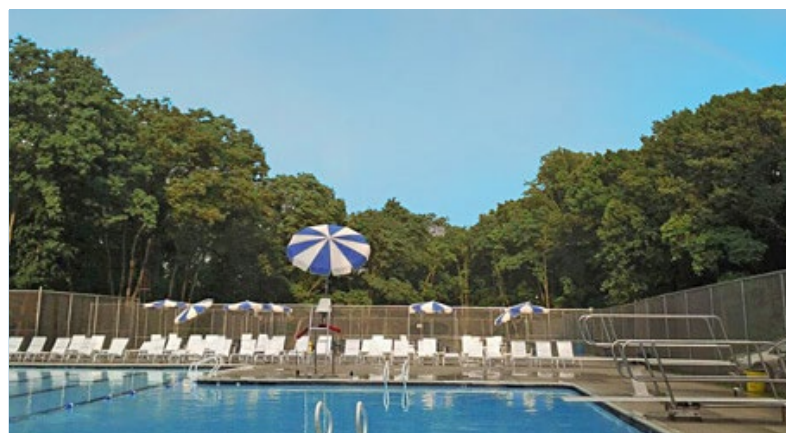
Camps will run for 5 weeks- June 27 through July 28, Monday – Thursday 9am -1pm. There will be no camp on July 4th.

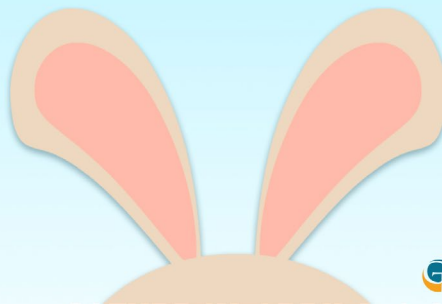
