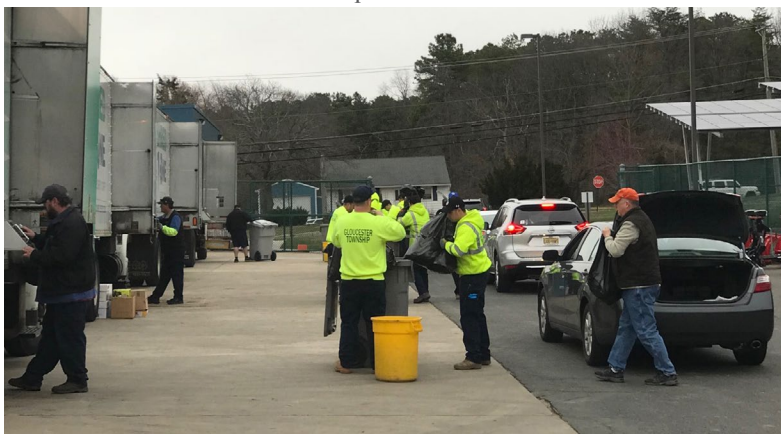

Take a ride around Gloucester Township with our GT Bike Kiosk and Bike Library!



The health and wellbeing of our residents is a huge priority in Gloucester Township. In 2017, Gloucester Township introduced GT Bike Share, a free bike kiosk service located alongside our health and fitness trail. In 2018, Gloucester Township launched GTWheels Sustainable Bike Library which operates on donated bikes which residents can use.

The difference between the two is that with GTWheels, all of the bikes are recycled or refurbished and you actually get to bring the bikes home! We hope you take advantage of these free programs.

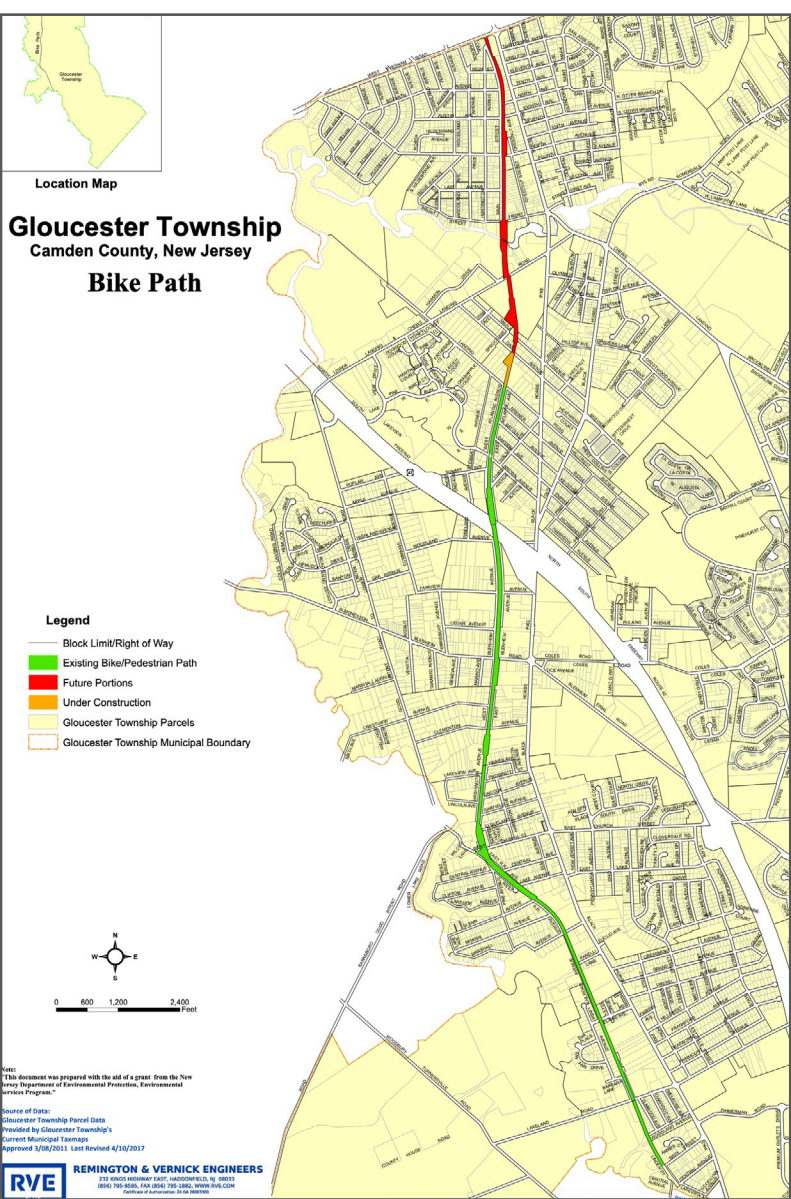

Gloucester Township Health and Fitness trail runs along an abandoned railroad bed. Starting in 1999, the existing trail has been constructed in eleven segments and now extends from Main Street near Grenloch Lake to Oak Avenue.

When completed, the trail will be approximately 4.4 miles in Gloucester Township and will connect the Township's northern border with Runnemede Borough to the southern border with Washington Township; it will offer excellent vistas of Timber Creek.

Both the existing and proposed trail go through several communities in Gloucester Township. It is near or adjacent to several schools, recreational facilities and commercial centers. Parts of the trail area also adjacent to undeveloped natural parts of the Township. This overall trail is an important part of the Circuit Trails and will eventually serve as a link between the multi-use trail networks in Camden County and Gloucester County. The Circuit Trails are endorsed as a regional priority in the DVRPC's Connections 2045 Plan for Greater Philadelphia.

It’s Prom Season and Gloucester Township Police wants our teens to have fun AND STAY SAFE, so please take a moment and read these Prom Safety

- Facts before your kid heads off to their prom this week:**
- High school students who drink or use drugs are 7X more likely to engage in high-risk behavior.
 - Car accidents are the leading cause of death in teenagers with April, May & June being the most dangerous months.
 - 70% of teens killed on prom weekend were not wearing seat belts.
 - 39% of 16 -19 year-olds stated that they or their friends would use drugs or alcohol on prom night.
 - 87% of teens believe their peers are likely to drive impaired instead of calling their parent or guardian for help because they are afraid of getting in trouble.
- Carefully planning one of the most special events of a high school student’s entire career in advance and knowing about potential safety issues will make Prom Night a huge success and an unforgettable time!
