# GEMS SOLAR PARK RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY

Last week Mayor David Mayer, Congressman Donald Norcross, Former New Jersey Governor Jim Florio, Director of Camden County Board of Commissioners Louis Cappelli, Jr., and other state, county, and local officials cut the ribbon for GEMS Solar Park located at the nation's first superfund site at the northwest corner of the intersection of Hickstown Road and New Brooklyn-Erial Road. The Solar Park is estimated to produce 6,086,000 kWh of clean zero emissions power per year. Construction started in November 2021; the solar system was energized on April 14, 2022 and was built utilizing local union electricians from IBEW 351.
