Fall 2022 Preschool: Registration Still Open

Gloucester Township Recreation Center is still accepting applications for the fall preschool program. The Recreation Center has been serving the community for over 35 years with the goal of providing Gloucester Township and surrounding communities with an affordable, professionally-run program to help preschoolers with socialization skills, beginning their independence and helping them prepare for their grade school years. Classes are held 4 days a week (Monday-Thursday). Children are grouped by the year they will enter Kindergarten. To be eligible for the 4-year-old program, your child must turn 4 by September 30th. 3 year-olds can begin the program during each session. For the fall session, your child must be 3 by September 30th, for winter session children must be 3 by December 15th, for Spring Session - by March 1st. Classes are limited to 10 children per teacher.


