# CONGRATULATIONS, LT. JIM SHRIVER, ON HIS RETIREMENT!

Lt. Jim Shriver started his career at the Runnemede Police Department in 1995 and was hired by Gloucester Township Police Department in August of 1997. He has served as a Patrol Officer, Field Officer, Shift Investigator, DARE Instructor in schools, and was assigned to the Crime Scene Unit. Lt. Shriver was promoted to Sergeant in 2003 and served as a Deputy Platoon Commander. In 2010 he was assigned as a Deputy Investigation Bureau Commander and Special Investigation Unit. He was promoted to Lieutenant in 2016 and served as a Platoon Commander in the Patrol Bureau. He was also assigned as the Investigation Bureau's Commander in 2019 where he currently served up to this day. He has received seven distinguished unit citations, 2 merit awards, seven outstanding police work letters, and is the only supervisor in the Gloucester Township Police Department's history who not only was nominated seven years in a row for "Supervisor of the Year," but is the only supervisor that has been awarded the award twice, in 2017 and 2021.


