# GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP BREAKS GROUND ON THE LUXURY DEVELOPMENT, THE LOFTS

Wednesday, October 19, 2022, Gloucester Township in partnership with M&T Realty, an affiliate of Edgewood Properties, one of the largest independently-owned real estate development and management companies in the United States, broke ground on The Lofts at Gloucester Township on Davistown Road. "This will be another spectacular residential project from M&T, a joint venture of Edgewood Properties, and a great addition in the growing Gloucester Township market," said Jack Morris CEO of Edgewood Properties. The property, which is within walking distance to Camden County College and the Gloucester Premium Outlets, will include 144 one-bedroom and 216 two-bedroom units, in addition to the hotel.
