



CAMDEN COUNTY ISSUES CODE BLUE




Commissioner Virginia Betteridge, liaison to the Camden County Department of Health and Human Services, advises municipalities that the region will be under a Code Blue Advisory starting TO-NIGHT, November 17th, into the morning of Tuesday, November 22nd.

The Health Officer has issued the Code Blue advisory for Camden County effective from 7 PM to 7 AM, beginning November 17th and ending the morning of November 22nd. Temperatures during the code blue will drop as low as 25 degrees.
