**Blankets for the Camden County Women's Shelter** – Create fleece tie blankets for the Camden County Women's Shelter children. (Activity takes place at C.W. Lewis Middle School).

**Blenheim Fire Company** – Help the men and women of the Fire Department with firehouse duties.

<u>Camden County Animal Shelter</u> – Assist in the care of sheltered animals (limit of 25)

<u>Camden County Animal Shelter</u> – Treats – Stuffing kongs with a peanut butter mixture for dogs at the shelter. (Activity takes place at CW Lewis Middle School).

<u>Camden County Greenhouse</u> – Work in the Greenhouse planting seeds for the upcoming year.
