

- Nominators must submit an essay supporting his/her nominee's accomplishments.





Help GTPD Solve Crime In Your Neighborhood!

The Gloucester Township Police Department is requesting residents, businesses, and organizations that have security cameras in place on their property to complete a short registration form.

The registration DOES NOT give the Gloucester Township Police Department access to your camera system, and only allows our agency to maintain a data base reference of active cameras in the event a crime occurs in the area. For example if a burglary occurs down the street from your property, we would know your camera may have captured an image of a vehicle or suspect that could connect us to the suspects involved in the burglary. A detective would be able to contact you and ask to review the footage in hopes of identifying a suspect description or any information that can help the case.

(Children must be 5 years of age on or before September 30.)

If you are unable to register virtually, you may register in person at Ann A. Mullen Middle School, Tuesday, March 28, 5:00-7:30 PM Glen Landing Middle School, Thursday, March 30, 5:00-7:30 PM

The following documents will be needed for registration

- 1. Original Birth Certificate
- 3. Custody Papers (if applicable)
- 4. Two Proofs of Residency If you own or are buying your home, please bring your sale agreement, or current tax bill and a current utility bill. If you are rentling, please bring a copy of your current lease and a current utility bill. If you are living with someone else (family member, friend, etc.), please bring a notarized affidavit, current tax bill and a current utility bill for the owner. You must also provide two additional proofs of residency (current bill, address change notice from the post office, or bank statement) along with the affidavit.

- DPT minimum of four doses. One dose must be administered on or after the fourth birthday.

 Polio minimum of three doses. One must be given on or after the fourth birthday.

 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) two doses of measles-containing vaccine given on or after the first birthday
- Hepatitis B -three doses
- Varicella (chicken pox) one dose. Additionally, all children will be required to have a complete physical given by their family physician prior to entering kindergarten in September.
