



the position of Special Law Enforcement Officer Class II (SLEO II).

Candidates who possess a current New Jersey Police Training Commission certification as a SLEO II or retired police officers who separate from prior police service in good standing, and with proper training who satisfy the other requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146, may apply.

The Special Law Enforcement Officer Class II is a part time member of the Gloucester Township Police Department. SLEO Class II officers are assigned in a part time capacity to provide public safety and law enforcement services to a public entity. SLEO Class II officers maintain order at public gatherings. SLEO Class II officers may regulate and control pedestrian and vehicular traffic to assure safe and rapid traffic movement, and any other law enforcement support role needed.
