Effective April 1, 2023, Lt. Melissa Capanna retired from the Gloucester Township Police Department after 25 years of honorable service as a full time Gloucester Township Police Officer. Lt. Capanna was hired as a Gloucester Township Police Officer on March 30, 1998. Lt. Capanna served as a Patrol Officer, Field Training Officer, School Resource Officer, and a Crisis Negotiator. She was promoted to Sergeant of Police on October 6, 2014, and served as a Deputy Platoon Commander, and a Deputy Commander of the Juvenile Family Services Bureau. She was promoted to Lieutenant of Police on September 1, 2019, and served as a Platoon Commander, Community Relations Bureau Commander, Crisis Negotiations Team Commander, and a member of the Departmental Wellness Committee.

Effective April 1, 2023, Det. Ronald Middleton retired from the Gloucester Township Police Department after 25 years and 3 months of honorable service as a full time Gloucester Township Police Officer. Det. Middleton was hired as a Gloucester Township Police Officer on January 26, 1998. Det. Middleton served as a Patrol Officer, Field Training Officer, and a Patrol Shift Investigator. He was appointed as a Detective on January 26, 2005, and served in the Juvenile Investigations Unit, Criminal Investigations Unit, and the Professional Standards Unit.




