MAYOR MAYER DEDICATES A FLAGPOLE AND UNVEILS THE VETERANS MONUMENT AT HARWAN PARK

Today, Mayor David Mayer, Assemblyman Paul Moriarty, and American Legion Post 281 dedicated a flagpole and unveiled the Veterans' Memorial that was relocated to Harwan Park from the intersection of Black Horse Pike and Church Street.

The Monument was previously positioned on the wall of the First Presbyterian Church's cemetery and became dislodged. The new location of the monument (center of Harwan Park) will allow for safe and comfortable congregation of individuals willing to pay tribute to the fallen heroes.

HARWAN PARK RENOVATIONS

The second phase of Harwan Park improvements is completed with the flower bed redone and pavers installed replacing the river rock. The former wooden frame of the flower bed was replaced with the flat stone surface that visitors can use to sit for awhile. The Veterans' Memorial is placed in the center of the park and allows for traditional ceremonies and gatherings to be held comfortably with extra permanent seating around it.
