VOLUNTEERS COMPLETE A COMMUNITY PROJECT IN THE HISTORIC DOWNTOWN BLACKWOOD SECTION OF GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP

Over the span of 3 days, community volunteers painted the 93 year-old iron fence in the historic Downtown Blackwood section of Gloucester Township. The project was organized and led by a Gloucester Township small business owner, Nick Rehrig, of Krieg and Sieg. Nick is also a stakeholder in the Gloucester Township Neighborhood Preservation Committee and proposed this project of painting the cemetery's fence to other members of the team this past winter. Last week, in preparation for the project, the Department of Public Works power washed the retaining wall and the sidewalks surrounding the cemetery of the First Presbyterian Church.

On Tuesday, the volunteers used power tools and metal brushes to scrub the fence of the rust and old paint. The volunteers then primed and painted the fence with high-gloss paint that had been kindly donated for the project by Becky Piacentino, a representative of Sherwin Williams – Haddon Heights.

Total Project Time: 23 hours

Total Length of the Fence: 325 feet with over 1000 spindles!
