ARTIST DAVID KNAUER STARTS MURAL



If you were in the Downtown Blackwood section of Gloucester Township this past Friday night, you might have seen artist David Knauer projecting lights on the wall and tracing an image. David was hired by the Neighborhood Preservation Team to paint a historical mural on one of the buildings in the Arts District. The owner of 21-23-25 N Black Horse Pike kindly donated the wall for the project, and David officially started painting his artwork on Monday, July 3rd.

About the artist: David Knauer was born and raised in South Jersey. David is experienced in many types of art mediums, including oil, aerosol, pen, ink, etc. You can see Dave's murals in Pitman, NJ. He is also an accomplished tattoo artist specializing in photorealistic work, portraits, and black and grey art. David reviewed various historical photographs provided by the Gloucester Township Historical Committee in order to create a mural for the historic Downtown Blackwood section of Gloucester Township. David's friend, Rob Ortiz, is helping him with the mural. Rob works for Atlanticare as a software developer and enjoys art and graphic design as his hobbies.
