Get to know our Town Hero, Letisha "Tish" Smith!

Letisha entered the United States Air Force on April 5th, 1995 and completed six weeks of basic training at Lackland Air Force Base in San Antonio, Texas, graduating with the rank of Airman First Class, E-3. She served 3 1/2 years of active duty. While on active duty, she was stationed at Grand Forks Air Force Base in Grand Forks, North Dakota. She also had the opportunity to visit several countries and was deployed in August of 1996 to the 4408th Air Refueling Squadron of the 4404th Wing, Prince Sultan Air Base, Al Kharj, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

Her merits and decorations include Air Force Training Ribbon, National Defense Service Medal, Marksman, Air Force Achievement Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Air Force Outstanding Unit Award w/Valor with one device, and Good Conduct Medal. After her years of service and honorable discharge, she returned to Camden County, New Jersey and has been an employee of the Camden County Board of Social Services since January of 1999, under her current title of Senior Investigator of the county welfare agency.

Letisha has been a resident of Gloucester Township New Jersey since 2019 where she lives with her two children Sheila Simone Smith and Storm Jackson Smith.

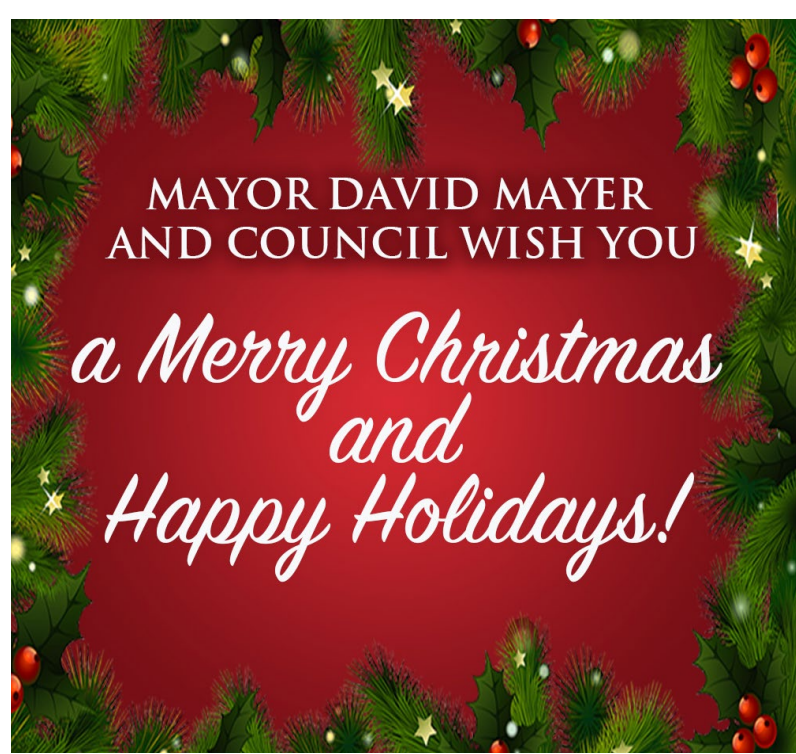
HOLIDAY WASTE COLLECTION ADVISORY
