GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP AWARD-ED OVER \$948,000 FROM NJ GREEN ACRES PROGRAM

Funds to be used to redevelop Taylor Avenue Play-ground

GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP, NJ – The Township of Gloucester was recently awarded \$948,630 from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection’s (DEP) Green Acres Program to transform Taylor Avenue Playground in to a multi-generational recreational facility, announced Mayor David Mayer today.

“We are appreciative of the Green Acres award and very pleased that our application was so favorably received,” said Mayor Mayer. “This money will allow us to make a number of improvements at Taylor Avenue that encourages uses by residents of all ages.”

Created in 1961 to meet New Jersey’s growing recreation and conservation needs, the Green Acres Program has directly protected more than 1.5 million acres of open space and provided hundreds of outdoor recreational facilities in communities around the state.

The Township’s application was written by Triad Associates of Vineland – a community and economic development firm that has secured more than \$1.6 billion in funding for its clients over the past 45 years.

Under the Green Acres application, the Township will replace the existing outdated playground equipment, install an obstacle source for teens and older children, and create a fitness area for adults and seniors. Additionally, pedestrian linkages within the park will be improved to provide easier access for users.

“Gloucester Township has long been committed to providing quality open space and recreational facilities for residents and visitors alike,” Mayor Mayer concluded. “This latest award is a continuation of that commitment.”

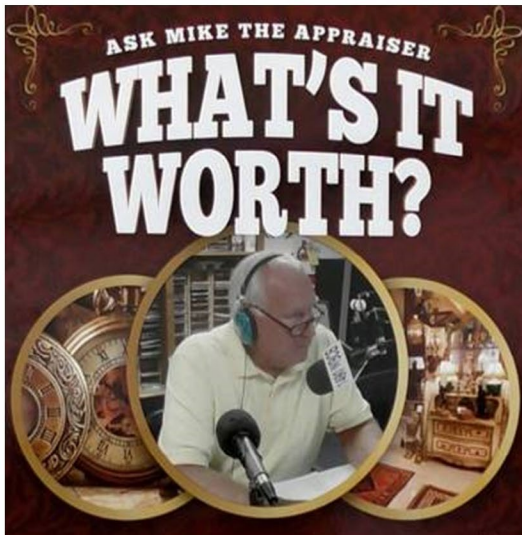

Once paver is purchased you will receive a proof to approve.
