COMMUNITY AND ARTS CENTER UPDATE

Mayor David Mayer visited the renovation site of the future Gloucester Township Community Arts Center in the Downtown Blackwood where Phase One of construction is currently ongoing. The contractor is working on the roof, the entrance, and the ADA portion of the project. Residents can expect to see major façade improvements in the near future further enhancing the historic Downtown Blackwood Section of Gloucester Township. Phase One is expected to be completed in November of this year. The Community and Arts Center will be a "shared space" where Gloucester Township residents and entities such as, but not limited to, the Library and Mainstage Center for Performing Arts, will hold their events and other happenings. Local artists' exhibitions, community classes, non-profit organizations' meetings and events can take place at the center which will become the pinnacle and a community hub of the Gloucester Township Arts District in Downtown Blackwood.
