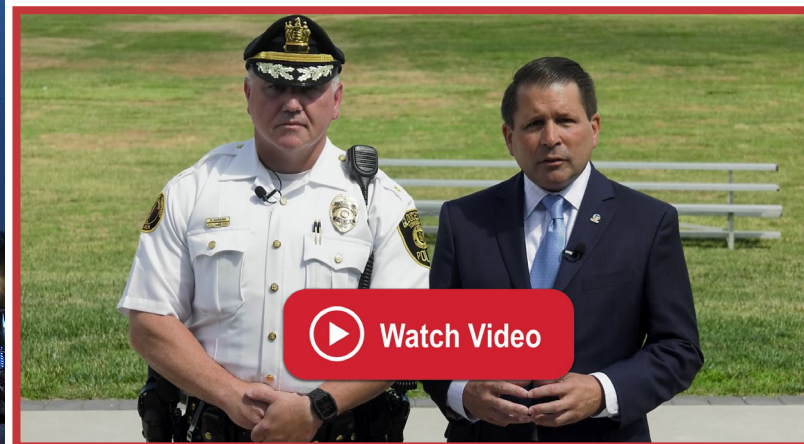

PUBLIC WORKS HOSTS ANNUAL BACKHOE ROADEO

Mayor Mayer visited the 2024 American Public Works Association Backhoe Roadeo hosted by the Gloucester Township Department of Public Works on June 11, 2024, at Gloucester Township Community Park.

This annual event provides participants with heavy equipment to test their skills. Individuals were tested on their driving ability while navigating through an obstacle course. Competition included skill tests for backhoe, skid steer, mini excavator, and an electric zero-turn mower. Contestants must be current employees of a municipal or county public works agency.

There were 14 contestants from Bellmawr, Runnemede, Haddonfield, Roxbury, Pitman, and other towns. Congratulations to Haddonfield - the grand champion!
