
GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY ARTS CENTER UPDATE

Mayor Mayer is thrilled to announce exciting progress on transforming our historic bank building into Gloucester Township's Multi-Use Community Center and Black Box Theater right in the heart of the Arts District!

Here's a glance at the progress that has been made so far: The old glass and aluminum entry doors have been taken out and fresh new stairs have been poured. The roof has been repaired and new windows have been installed to brighten up the space. Inside, the bathrooms are now complete, and a handicap lift has been added to ensure everyone can enjoy the theater. A centerpiece of the bank building's history, the old clock, has been diligently worked on.

A special thank you goes out to Assemblyman Dan Hutchison, Senator Paul Moriarty, and Assemblyman Cody Miller for incredible support and allocating an additional \$500,000 to the project.
