The 1756 Gabreil Daveis Tavern Museum House is open for tours in 2024 April through November every 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month from 1-4pm and the first two Sundays in December. (Closed on holidays.) **November 10th** will feature supervised metal detecting, so bring your equipment or observe others.

House tours on both dates will include local history and stories as you walk through the rooms. The trail to the creek will be open to explore and experience how colonial travelers came up to the Tavern. Admission is free, but donations are accepted.
