GROUND BREAKING CEREMONY AT LITTLE POND



Mayor David R. Mayer and Councilwoman Helen Albright-Troxell attended the groundbreaking ceremony for Little Pond Village, a new mixed-use development at 1110 Chews Landing Road, the former site of Little Pond Golf Center.

The project includes 81 town homes and a 20,000-square-foot commercial building, aiming to enhance local housing options and boost economic growth in Gloucester Township.

The development will feature a single access road from Chews Landing Road, leading to both the commercial area and residential units. The existing commercial properties housing a pizza shop and liquor store will remain unaffected.

Mayor Mayer expressed enthusiasm for the project, highlighting its potential to revitalize the area and provide valuable amenities to residents. The development is expected to attract new businesses and offer modern living spaces, contributing to the township's ongoing growth and community development.

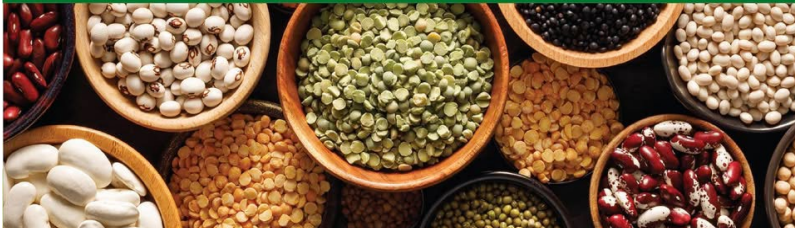
