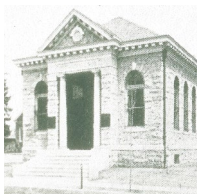

"THE NEXUS" SECURES DYNAMIC HOST FOR UPCOMING NETWORKING EVENT



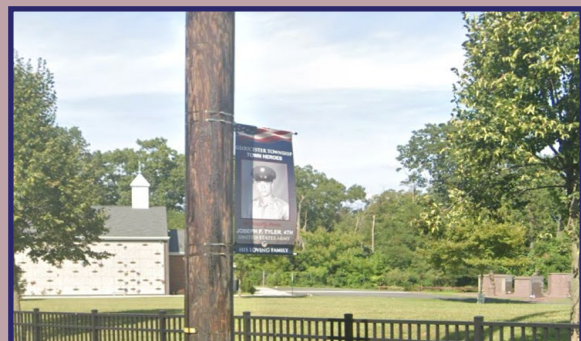

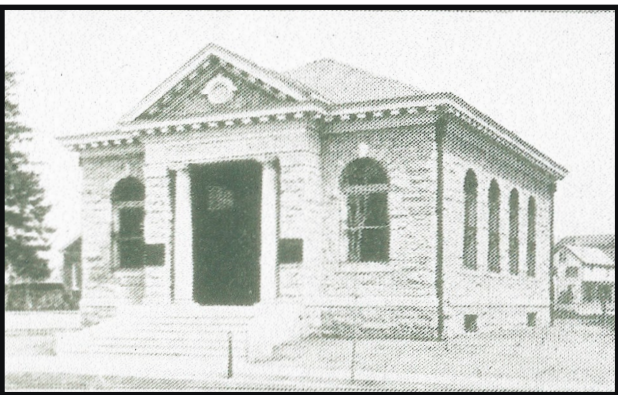

In 2025, the Township continues its rehabilitation plan to restore a historic downtown building to be used as a black box theater, for community meeting spaces, lectures, downtown community event space and other uses that would encourage diverse community gatherings.

To date, the Township has completed phase 1 of the structural renovations that included repairs needed for the exterior of the building. Currently, the plan has entered phase 2 of the project which would allow the Township to complete the interior renovations that includes any necessary fixtures, appurtenances, furnishings and equipment.
