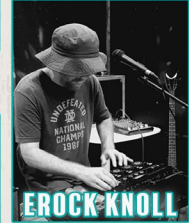

The 1756 Gabreil Daveis Tavern Museum House was once owned by Revolutionary War major, George Payne. Payne was a soldier, leader, and a once owner of a Privateer, Comet. Come out and learn about George Payne and shipbuilding along the North Branch of Timber Creek. Dress as a pirate and receive a treat! Tours of the historic house will be ongoing. The trail to the creek will be open to explore. (Only on October 26th, also watch a neighborhood Halloween parade held on the grounds!) Admission is free, but donations are accepted.
