

# Fall Leaf Collection Continues!

# SHRED DAY THIS SATURDAY!

**FALL LEAF COLLECTION**

Public Works will begin Leaf Collection on November 3, 2025. Look for signs on the road. **Don't Worry!** If you miss your round, we will continue to collect until all leaves are picked up.

**To make this program a success, please adhere to the following:**

- Try to keep all leaves unbagged at curbside. If you must use bags, **please use paper bags only.**
- Have all leaves out the weekend prior to your week.
- Rake all leaves curbside. Do not rake leaves into the street if it will block traffic.
- Do not mix trash and broken branches with leaves. This clogs the machines and **your leaves will not be picked up.**
- Do not park any vehicles in front of leaves during your pick-up week. **They will not be picked up.**



This free event is a great opportunity to safely dispose of confidential papers and help protect yourself from identity theft. Open to all residents — come early, as the event will end once the trucks are full!

Gloucester Township's annual Fall Leaf Collection is underway and will continue until all leaves are picked up. Residents are reminded to keep leaves unbagged at the curb, or use large paper bags if needed. Please do not rake leaves into the street, mix in trash or branches, or park in front of leaf piles during your collection week.

Gloucester Township is going green—help us by using paper bags and labeling them clearly with grass, brush, or leaves. Collection runs through early December. Thank you for helping keep our community clean and beautiful this fall!
