## Proposed Improvements at Community Park



The Township of Gloucester is seeking funding through the State of NJ Green Acres Program for improvements at Community Park, located at 300 Hickstown Road, at the intersection of Peter Cheeseman Road and Hickstown Road in Gloucester Township.

The Township of Gloucester proposes to make the following improvements at Community Park: replace an aging playground with a new multi-generational playground and a picnic shelter, along with related improvements. A concept plan showing the proposed changes, a preliminary cost estimate, and an environmental impact assessment for the project [CLICK HERE](#).

The public is encouraged to attend a public hearing to learn more about the proposal and to ask questions or provide comments on the proposed plan on Monday, February 9, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting will be held in-person in Township Council Chambers, Municipal Building, 1261 Chews Landing Road.


## Cubs in Action: Tour of Police and Municipal Building


